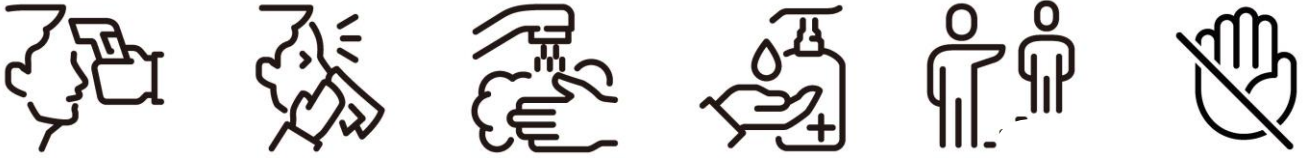


# Notices to visitors



## Services that are suspended until further notice:

- o Discounts such as *Silver Day* and *Family Day* that attract crowds.
- o Reservation priority for the library.
- o Water coolers in the museum.

## Requests to visitors:

- o Temperatures will be taken at the entrance to the museum. Visitors who have a high fever or symptoms such as coughing, sore throat will be refused entry.
- o Refrain from visiting the museum if you have traveled within the past two weeks to countries or regions where infections are continuing to increase.
- o Visitors who have had close contact with people who turned out to be positive of COVID19.
- o Visitors who suspected infections with family or friends.
- o Visitors with large luggage over 55cm high will be refused entry.
- o Visitors without masks will kindly be refused entry.
- o Please wearing a mask, avoiding coughing near others, washing and disinfecting your hands.
- o Please follow to keep *Social Distancing* in the museum.
- o Please cooperate with cashless payment.
- o Minimize conversation and do not touch the wall, exhibition cases in the gallery.
- o Please take note of the date and time of your visit as for your reference.
- o Please let us know immediately, if you are not feeling well.

## Facility use:

- o The entrance is the main gate and west only. South entrance, the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, is closed.
- o Elevator capacity is 4 limited. People with disabilities, elderly people, and pregnant are given priority.
- o Restriction of the number of visitors in order to prevent overcrowding.

## Measures taken by TOP MUSEUM to prevent the spread of infection:

- o Museum staff conduct daily temperature checks and confirm that they are in good health.
- o All staff wear masks, faceguards, and gloves as necessities.
- o Acrylic panels installed at the reception counters and so on.
- o Disinfectant placed at the entrance to the museum.
- o Thorough cleaning, disinfection, and ventilation inside the building.
- o Coordination with the public health center if visitors or staff develop symptoms.
